**Persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic chemicals (PBT)**

Dear Sirs,

Reference is made to your inquiry regarding Endress+Hauser's compliance with the **Toxic Substances Control Act of 1976 (TSCA) Section 6(h)**. As required under the TSCA the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) concerning the making available on the market and the use of five persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic chemicals (PBT).

These chemicals build up in the environment over time and can therefore have potential risks for exposed populations, including the general population, consumers and commercial users, and susceptible subpopulations (such as workers, subsistence fishers, tribes and children).


